TRAVEL BY TRAIN

The Sci-Tech campus is located within easy reach of four local train stations, which are all accessible by jumping on one of the bus services that connect to the campus.

WARRINGTON CENTRAL

Can be reached in just over 25 minutes on bus service 62A. Provides regular services between Manchester and Liverpool.

WARRINGTON BANK QUAY

Can be reached in around 30 minutes on bus service 62A. Provides services to key local destinations and high-speed services to national destinations such as London, Edinburgh and Leeds.

RUNCORN

Reached in around 40 minutes on bus service 200. Provides services to destinations such as London, Liverpool, Birmingham and Chester.

RUNCORN EAST

Can be reached in around 20 minutes on bus service 200. Provides regular services to destinations including Leeds, Manchester Airport and Chester.

BUS SERVICES TO SCI-TECH DARESBUURY

Currently there are two services available from the stops on Keckwick Lane on campus.

200 Runcorn Circular



Offers a service approximately every 30 minutes during peaks and every hour off peak.




62A Warrington - Runcorn



Offers an approximately hourly service in the peak, with 3 AM services towards Sci-Tech and 4 PM services towards Warrington. No off peak services.



There's also a service available from the stops on A56, a short walk away from campus, the **X30 Chester - Warrington**, which offers an hourly service between 6am and 6pm, in either direction.
